At Star Player, we are dedicated to supporting the growth and development of children and young people, using sport and enrichment as powerful tools to foster both physical and emotional well-being. Our programmes encourage discipline, structure, and healthier lifestyles while also helping young people develop resilience and decision-making skills. By providing positive role models, particularly in communities where this is most needed, we create trusted relationships that allow us to engage deeply with children and generate meaningful insights. These insights enable us to provide schools, local authorities, and partner organisations with detailed feedback and recommendations that contribute to better outcomes for the children in their care.

In addition to 1-1 mentoring and sports sessions delivered both on and off-site, we provide flexible wraparound care services that support working parents and give children a safe, structured start and finish to their school day. Our provision goes beyond traditional childcare by integrating enrichment activities, ensuring children are engaged, supported, and inspired throughout.

We also deliver specialist and niche classes, and creative enrichment projects. For example, at Chelsea School we have successfully introduced after-school archery and karate sessions, which not only promote fitness and self-discipline but also give children access to unique experiences that build confidence and broaden horizons.

Alongside these targeted programmes, our Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) camps combine physical activity with social, emotional, and educational support, ensuring children thrive during the school holidays. We currently work with nurseries, mainstream schools, and Pupil Referral Units (PRUs) across Hounslow, Surrey, and Bournemouth, and are expanding rapidly. Every programme is delivered in close partnership with families, carers, and school staff, ensuring clear goals, shared expectations, and smooth delivery.

OUR SERVICES

At Star Player, we design programmes that schools and organisations can tailor to meet their specific objectives. Whether you need wraparound childcare, mentoring for vulnerable young people, or enrichment through sport and creative activities, our services can be delivered as one-off projects, termly interventions, or year-long programmes.





CHOOSE THE SUPPORT THAT FITS YOUR NEEDS

Mentoring Services

At Star Player, we specialise in 1-1 and small group mentoring that gives children and young people the extra support they need to thrive. Our mentors work closely with schools to build confidence, develop positive routines, and encourage life skills that help pupils both in and out of the classroom. By focusing on personal growth alongside academic progress, we help re-engage students in education while providing schools and families with detailed feedback and progress tracking. This tailored approach is particularly effective for pupils with additional needs, those at risk of exclusion, or those requiring targeted social, emotional, and behavioural support. Above all, our mentoring is about helping each young person see their potential, develop resilience, and believe they can succeed.

Wraparound Care

Our breakfast and after-school clubs provide safe, structured childcare solutions that support working parents and extend the school day in a meaningful way.

Breakfast Club: Opens from 7:30am, includes healthy meals and light activities.

After-School Club: Runs until 6:00pm with snacks, homework support, and a variety of supervised activities.

Schools that partner with us benefit from a flexible wraparound care model that blends structured play, enrichment, and learning opportunities, ensuring children are supported and engaged before and after lessons.

After-School Sports

We provide a wide variety of after-school clubs that engage children of all interests and abilities. Alongside popular sports such as football, basketball, dodgeball, and tag rugby/NFL, we also run creative and technology-based clubs including coding, arts & crafts, Lego building, and supervised gaming.

Many schools choose our niche enrichment sessions, such as karate and archery (currently running at Chelsea School), which give children access to unique, confidence-building experiences. Every session is delivered by qualified staff who create a fun, inclusive environment that complements the school's wider curriculum.

Holiday Activities & Food (HAF) Camps

Our HAF programmes offer children enriching and safe holiday experiences that combine sports, arts, and educational workshops with nutritious meals. Camps are inclusive and tailored to support pupils with additional needs or those in receipt of free school meals. For schools, partnering with Star Player means providing families with trusted holiday provision that keeps children active, engaged, and supported outside of term time.

1-2-1 Football Coaching

Our personalised football coaching helps young players develop technical skills, fitness, and confidence. Sessions are high-energy, high-intensity, and tailored to each child's goals. Many schools use this service for their gifted and talented pupils or as an enrichment opportunity that supports progression both on and off the pitch.

SEND Specialist Camps

We design specialist programmes for children with SEND that offer adaptive activities in a safe and supportive environment. These camps are led by trained practitioners who understand how to create inclusive experiences that empower children to grow socially, emotionally, and physically. Schools and local authorities value this service as an extension of their SEND offer, ensuring all children have access to tailored enrichment opportunities.

Short Breaks Provision

Our Short Breaks services give children and young people with SEND safe, structured opportunities to learn, play, and build independence while providing families and carers with valuable respite. Activities are carefully adapted to individual needs, ensuring every child is included and able to thrive.

Local authorities and schools value this provision as it enhances the SEND offer, promotes social development, and provides families with the consistent support they need.
